There will be no homework over Thanksgiving break. However, I have sent home several extra credit opportunities in today's folder. Homework will be sent home on Monday, November 28th.

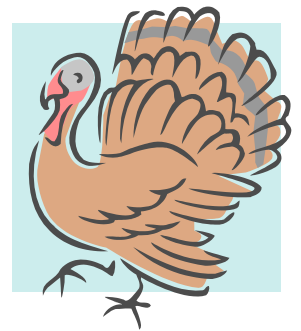
Puzzle Pieces
